► The Board met for the second readings of Ordinances for speed limits on Westside Road, Golf Course Road, West Bridge Road, West Fork Road, and Middle Burnt Fork Road at 3:00 p.m. Present were Road & Bridge Supervisor David Ohnstad and William Menager.

Commissioner Iman called the meeting to order and confirmed proper publication and notice has been given. He then began the second readings of the proposed ordinances.

**Commissioner Chilcott made a motion to approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 23 establishing speed limit on Westside Road. Commissioner Foss seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

**Commissioner Chilcott made a motion to approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 24 establishing speed limit on Golf Course Road. Commissioner Foss seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

**Commissioner Stoltz made a motion to approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 25 establishing speed limit on West Bridge Road. Commissioner Foss seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

**Commissioner Chilcott made a motion to approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 26 establishing speed limit on Middle Burnt Fork Road. Commissioner Foss seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

**Commissioner Stoltz made a motion to approve the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 27 establishing speed limit on West Fork Road. Commissioner Foss seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

David requested Board approval to move forward with request for bids for the West Fork Road guard rail replacement. The Board concurred.
