► The Board met at 9:00 a.m. to cancel Special District Elections for the Conservation, Drainage, Fire, Irrigation, Library and Park Districts. Present was Clerk & Recorder Regina Plettenberg. Commissioner Iman was not present due to another scheduled matter.

**Commissioner Chilcott made a motion to adopt Resolutions No. 2825 and No. 2826 cancelling the certain special elections as presented. Commissioner Stoltz seconded the motion and all voted "aye". (4-0)**

► The Board met at 10:00 a.m. for a Forest Service update with Julie King. Commissioner Iman was not present due to another scheduled matter.

► The Board met at 1:10 p.m. for a discussion of HB 130 grant monies and contracts in regard to the Sheriff's Office. Present were CFO Klarryse Murphy, Sheriff Chris Hoffman, Undersheriff Perry Johnson and citizen William Menager. Commissioner Foss was not present. Commissioner Iman gave a brief update regarding a request made from the Sheriff's Office to substitute \$23,000 of HB 130 monies for crisis intervention training to remodel the mental health special needs room with a recording surveillance system such as cameras to begin at intake. Commissioner Kanenwisher expressed his concern with the criteria for HB 130 monies and suggested contacting Deb Mattuca regarding utilizing recordings for educational purposes, monitoring and possibly assisting in diagnoses. The Board concurred with Commissioner Kanenwisher. Commissioners discussed the required language of the request for guideline compliance. Discussion developed to include how the surveillance would be used for educational purposes such as how to recognize self-threatening behavior.
